Students and Parents - A few reminders about band camp:

- **Health Forms** – Will now be printed directly from Power School. You will **NOT** need to bring a Health Form to Band Camp.
- **Medications** -All medications will be turned over to, and dispensed by, the TMA chaperone on duty. Bring the necessary medications with you at time of registration.
- **Rules and Policies** - The Timberlane Regional High School Student Handbook will apply at all times during the week.
- **Lunch** - Bring a bag lunch, including beverage, with you every day. **NO ONE WILL** be allowed to **leave to get lunch elsewhere.**
- **MANDATORY** - Bring Instrument, music, pencil, supplies, hat & sunscreen – wear socks and sneakers – **NO SANDALS** and *A positive 'CAN DO' attitude!!!!!! (This is up to You and Only YOU!!)*
- **NOT ALLOWED** - Non-band friends “visiting” - Water/Squirt guns in the building - and negative Attitudes
- **Parking** - If you must drive yourself to band camp, your car will be parked in back of the school.
- **Leaving during Camp Hours?** - You may **NOT** leave band camp at any time ***without permission from Mr. Clark.*** If you must leave, for any reason, bring a note from a parent/guardian when you come to camp the first morning, at registration. (If possible, discuss this with Mr. Clark in advance.) When you do leave the school for an event, you are required to sign out at the chaperone table in the lobby and should be picked up inside by your parent, guardian or designated other person. Please don't forget to ***sign in*** when you return.
- **Uniforms** – Uniforms will be distributed for both marching and concert band at 4:00 p.m. as follows: Seniors, Monday; Juniors, Tuesday; Sophomores, Wednesday; and Freshmen, Thursday. Fridays will be available if needed. At this time students will be able to try on sizes of items ordered. Each student **must** have signed contract and \$30 for dry cleaning.
- **Chaperones** - Camp Timberlane will be well chaperoned at all times. Call a TMA representative if you are available to help at any time during camp and/or throughout the year.
